Eugene Fersen, author of "Is There a God" and "The Science of Being," was born in Petrograd, Russia. Most thoroughly educated in every major field of human knowledge, thinker and investigator by nature, he devoted much of his time, talents and vast resources, both of knowledge and wealth, to the study of the great Universal Forces and Laws of Nature, par-

Sent to this country in 1918 as the head of a Russian Educational Mission, Mr. Fersen, formerly Baron Fersen, has since become an American citizen, residing in Washington, D. C.
